

Horizon CobalJect 2000

Vitamin B12 Injection +Selenium

For the treatment and control of cobalt and selenium deficiency in sheep and cattle

ACTIVE CONSTITUENTS Each mL contains: 2000µg Hydroxocobalamin (Vitamin B12) and 4mg Selenium (as sodium selenate).

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice when necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than as directed on the label.

By subcutaneous (under the skin) injection to be given into the anterior half of the neck.

Lambs	0.5 mL at tailing or weaning
Ewes	1.5 mL pre-lambing
Hoggets	1 mL in early spring
Calves	2 – 3 mL from 2 months of age
Cows	4 – 6 mL pre-calving

DO NOT redose within 3 months of the previous dose.

- Do not exceed stated dose.
- Cobalt deficiency in soil and/or pasture leads to a lack of Vitamin B12 in body tissues of stock which subsequently may have poor growth rates and ill-thrift, particularly in young stock.
- Before treatment, establish selenium status of stock, pasture cobalt levels and more particularly the Vitamin B12 status of stock.
- Do not use this product unless animals are deficient in both cobalt and selenium.
- Treatment is likely to last only 4 – 6 weeks if liver storage levels of Vitamin B12 and pasture levels of cobalt are low.
- Treatment of pregnant ruminants should benefit newborn animals, particularly when treated in latter stages of pregnancy.
- Supplementation of young ruminants should begin at or before weaning.
- Do not redose with this product within three months of the previous dose. Within this period re-treat with a non-selenised Vitamin B12 supplement.
- DO NOT use at the same time as any other Selenised fertilizer, pill or product without consulting a veterinarian.
- Seek veterinary advice if poor stock condition persists after treatment.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS Milk and Meat: **NIL**

STORAGE Store below 25°C. Protect from light. Once opened, must be used within one month.

READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USE May be harmful if swallowed.

FIRST AID If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/-physician if you feel unwell. For advice, contact the National Poisons Centre: 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor.
